



On the heels of accomplishing major career highs, like dueting with Barry Manilow at the Hollywood Palladium and selling her first indie film, "The Three Amigas," at the Cannes Short Corner, Pamela realized the long road to recovery ahead meant she had to pause her acting and singing pursuits.

Despite hitting rock bottom, Pamela's inherent joie de vivre meant it was only a matter of time until she picked herself back up. In fact, it was in recovery that Pamela decided to marry her two passions in life - travel and storytelling - which would inevitably take her on a journey to the farthest corners of the world. She made an "80 by 50" promise to herself - travel to 80 countries before turning 50 years old - and the minute she regained her strength, it was wheels up for Pamela.


